JAHANGIR.

- Sisodiya ruler of Mewar Amar Singh accepted his rule
- Knowledge prince Salim
- Wife Noor Jahan (Mehrunnisa) loyal and supportive had seals and coins with her name.

SHAH JAHAN

- Prince khurram
- Afghan noble Khan Jahan Lodi was defeated
- Qandhar was lost to Safavids
- 1632 annexed Ahmednagar
- Aurangzeb was victorious and his three brothers including Dara Sukoh were killed.
- Shah Jahan was imprisoned for the rest of his life in Agra

AURANGZEB

- 16638 homes defeated but revealed again in 1680
- Initially successful against Shivaji (insulted him when he came to accept Mughal authority)
- Sent Army to Deccan
- 1685 Bijapur annexed
- 1687 Golconda annexed
- 1698 against Maratha who followed guerrilla warfare
- After his death succession conflict amongst his sons

SUCCESSION

Primogeniture: eldest son inherited his father's estate coparcenary inheritance or division of inheritance amongst all the sons – Mughals.
