CHAPTER NAME : - RULERS AND BUILDING (CH. – 5 HIS.)

INTERMINGLING .

In Vijayanagar, elephant stables of rulers were strongly influenced by the style of architecture found in the adjoining Sultanate of Bijapur and Golconda .

In Vrindavan near Mathura temples where similar to the Mughal place in Fatehpur Sikri style of architecture is from Northwest Iran (khurasan) for high selling roof and was used in Fatehpur Sikri. cross-fertilization of architectural forms took place .

Bengal - local rulers developed roof designed to resemble thatched hut, Mughals used this Bangla Dome .

Akbar's at Fatehpur Sikri - impact of architectural style of Gujarat and Malwa .

12th century : France build churches that where taller and lighter than earlier building. Gothic style had high pointed arches, use of a stained glass and painted with scenes drawn from the Bible and flying buttresses. Tall spires and bell
