EXPANSION DURING KHALJI DYNASTY.

Expansion occurred during Ghiyasuddin Balban Alauddin Khalji and Mohammad Tughlaq

Consolidating hinter lands of Ganga Yamuna doab- given to peasants and Agriculture.

New fortresses and towns were established to protect trade routes and to promote regional trade .

Second expansion: external Frontier and military expenditure in south Army captured horses elephants and slaves.

ALAUDDIN KHALJI'S CAMPAIGN:

Quwwat al- Islam Mosque you and minaret built in 12th century as congregational mosque described in Chronicles as debil -I kuhna (the old city). Enlarged by Iltutmish and Alauddin Khalji Minar was built by three Sultan qutbuddin Aybak, Iltutmish and Firoz Shah Tughlaq.

Begumpuri Mosque: by Muhammad Tughlaq main Mosque you of jahapana "sanctuary of world" his new capital in Delhi.

Moth Ki Masjid: built in the region of Sikandar Lodi by his minister.
