Degradation:- the wearing away or erosion of the earth's crust.

Aggradation:- the process of deposition of the eroded material .

Weathering:-the process of chemical or physical breaking down of the minerals in the rocks.

Gorges:- the steep sided valleys in the course of a river.

Glacial moraines:-the pieces of rocks, sand and silt that are deposited at the sides on the top and the bottom of the glacier.

Mushroom rocks: formed due to wind erosion, when the base of the rock gets eroded more that the upper half giving it the shape of a mushroom.

Moderate: neither too hot nor too cold.

Insolation:-amount of sunlight received by the Earth.
