PAST TENSE

The past tense is used to express an action that has been completed.

TYPES. OF PAST TENSE

- 1. Simple past tense
- 2. Past continuous
- 3. Past perfect
- 4. Past perfect continuous

Simple past tense:

The simple past tense is used:

- To express a past habit
 - Example: I went to bed early
 - When I was in school
- To express an action that was completed before the time of speaking
 - Example: The dancers performed well.
- To express an action that took place over a period of time in the past
- Example:I worked in a school from 2000 to 2002.

• To narrate a story:

Example: There lived a mighty king
In a huge palace.

Difference between simple past and present perfect:

We use the simple past tense to express an action which took place at some moment in the past and is not linked with the present.
