L-1 PRESENT TENSE (Contd.)

In simple present tense we use first form of the verb.

For eg. we take the verb *write*

Verb form of write is:

V1. V2 V3. V4. V5

Write, wrote, written, writing, writes

In simple present tense we use :

V1- write and. V5-writes

V2, V3 and V-4 is not used in simple present tense.

Now, the question arises when we use V1 (write)

Or V5(writes).

When the subject is in :

In first person -I, We

2nd person You

3rd. Person plural no. They

We use V1 or (write)

For eg.

I write notes from B.V.P app. everyday.

We write notes-----

You. Write notes -----

They write notes-----

1st,2nd and 3rd person plural number.
