L-6 PRESENT TENSE(Contd.)

I have discussed about structure of present continuous tense:

Subject + is/are/am+ v4

For example: She is watching movie.

If we want to change it in interrogative sentence

then ,start the sentence from helping verb.

And put the question mark at the end.

In the above example ,

She is watching movie.

Is she watching movie?

If we change it into negative sentence then:

She is watching movie.

She is not watching movie.(negative)

Here, we add not after helping verb.

One more example:

I am reading newspaper.

Am I reading newspaper?(interrogative)

I am not reading.(negative)
