Today, I am going to explain about present perfect tense.

PRESENT PERFECT TENSE:

Present perfect tense is used :

- To express an action completed in the past but linked with the present.
For example: The traffic police have declared a heavy penalty for those who violate traffic rules.
- To express an action that began in the past is Continuing in the present
Example: She has lived in this house for ten years.
- To express an action that has just been completed
She has just finished her project.
- To express past events for which the exact time is not given
Example: We have fulfilled our responsibility.
- To refer to news
Example: The President has pardoned some convicted criminals.
