SIMPLE FUTURE TENSE(Contd.)

Will is used :

When we decide to do something at

the time of speaking.

Example: I will have a glass of orange juice.

She will lie down for some time as

she is tired.

- **To express something that will definitely happen, something that can not be changed, something over which we do not have any control**

Examples(a) The scheme will be launched next month.

- **To express the views of the speaker:**
Example: I will consult a specialist for my eye problem.
I will not go for walk as it is very humid

- **To offer to do something**
Examples: I will make a cup of coffee for the guests.
I will pay your telephone bill.

- **To request somebody to do something**
Example: Will you bring my bag please?

To promise to do something :

Example: I will bring a golf set for you .
