**L-9 phrases and Idioms**

**A phrase is a group of two or more words functioning as a meaningful unit within a sentence or a clause. It is basically characterized as a grammatical unit at a level between a word and a clause.**

A phrase contains a headword

Which determines the grammatical nature of the phrase and it also contains one or more modifiers.

Types of phrases:

- 1.Noun Phrases
- 2.verb Phrases
- 3.Adjective Phrases
- 4.Adverb Phrases
- 5.Prepositional Phrases

1. Noun phrases-A noun phrase is a group of words built around a single noun.
