Subordinating conjunction

The subordinating conjunction are many in number and we use them regularly in our daily communication. Subordinate conjunctions have many properties and they can be grouped accordingly:

.Those which show cause and effect. (that show reason)

. Those which show the significance of time or place.

. Those which show condition.

example of cause and effect-

.I am not going to work because I am sick.

. I will not release her payment unless she completes her work.

Some of subordinating conjunctions are used to show the transition of place or time. Example:

.Whenever his sister was out working, her mother would take care of the house.

. I won't be back in Hyderabad until early next week.

. The girl ran to her father as soon as she saw him.
