CHAPTER NAME : - parliamentary form of Government (ch. – 2 civics)

TOPIC : - POWER OF THE PRESIDENT

Financial power :

- No money bill can be introduced in the parliament without his or her prior permission .
- Has the power to section money from the contingency fund.

Emergency power :

He / She can use his / her emergency power under the following conditions.

- In case of financial crisis.
- In case of failure of constitutional machinery.

- In case of foreign aggression.

Martial power :

He is the supreme commander of the defence forces of India.

Note :- the national emergency was declared for the first time in India in 1962. during Indo Chinese war.

The vice – president.

The constitution of India also provides for a vice president of Indian republic. Adams the office of the President of India in the absence of the president.

In case the president dies or resigns, the vice president acts as the President of India for a maximum period of six months or till a new President is elected.

Qualification and tenure for being elected as the vice President of India are the same as those for the president of India .
