Joseph Rudyard Kipling (1865-1936) was an English journalist, short story writer, poet, and novelist born in Bombay (now called Mumbai) in British India. Before he became a famous writer, he worked as a journalist and editor in India. Kipling's most popular works include *The Jungle Book* and *Kim*, and his poems *Mandalay*, *Gunga Din*, *The Gods of the Copybook Headings*, *The White Mans Burden*, and f Kipling's famous novel, *The Jungle Book*, has been made into a film. Kipling became the first English writer to win the Nobel Prize for Literature when he won the award in 1907, at the age of 42. He is the youngest recipient of the Nobel Prize for Literature til date. He was also selected for the British Poet laureateship and knighthood, but here fused them both.
