Elements of poetry: rhyme, rhythm, repetition, and imagery

The poet uses **rhythm, rhyme, and repetition**, as well as **imagery**, to set the mood of the poem. Rhythm is a regular, patterned repetition of sounds. Rhythm and rhyme together give a musicality to the poem.

The poet also creates internal rhyme by using two rhyming words in the same line. For example, in the line Weather and rain have undone it again, rain rhymes with again.
