Future Perfect Continuous Tense STRUCTURE

(a) Affirmative sentences: Subject + will/
shall + have + been + Vi +ing.

(b) Negative sentences: Subject + will/
shal +not + have been + Vi+ ing.

(c) Interrogative sentences Will/Shall +
Subject + havve been + V1 + ing

USAGE

This tense is used to express an action continuing beyond a point of time in future.

1. The students will have been studying English since Monday.
2. The girls will have been singing songs for two hours.
