- The English East India company was formed in 1600 by Queen Elizabeth 1.
- Granting sole right to carry trade in the East.
- The English established their settlements and factories at Masulipatnam, Patna, Dhaka (in Bengal)
- Built fort St. George (in Madras), Bombay and Sutanati, Kalikata and Govindpur .
- In 1611 AD, the British opened their first factory or trading deport in the south in Masulipatnam.
- In 1691 the English were granted Farman by the Mughal emperor Aurangzeb which exempted the British company from paying custom duties in Bengal.
- British envoy sir Thomas Rao got the permission from the Mughal emperor Jahangir to established their first factory at Surat.
- The trading companies used to buy Indian goods at very cheap rates and sell them in Europe at a very high price.
