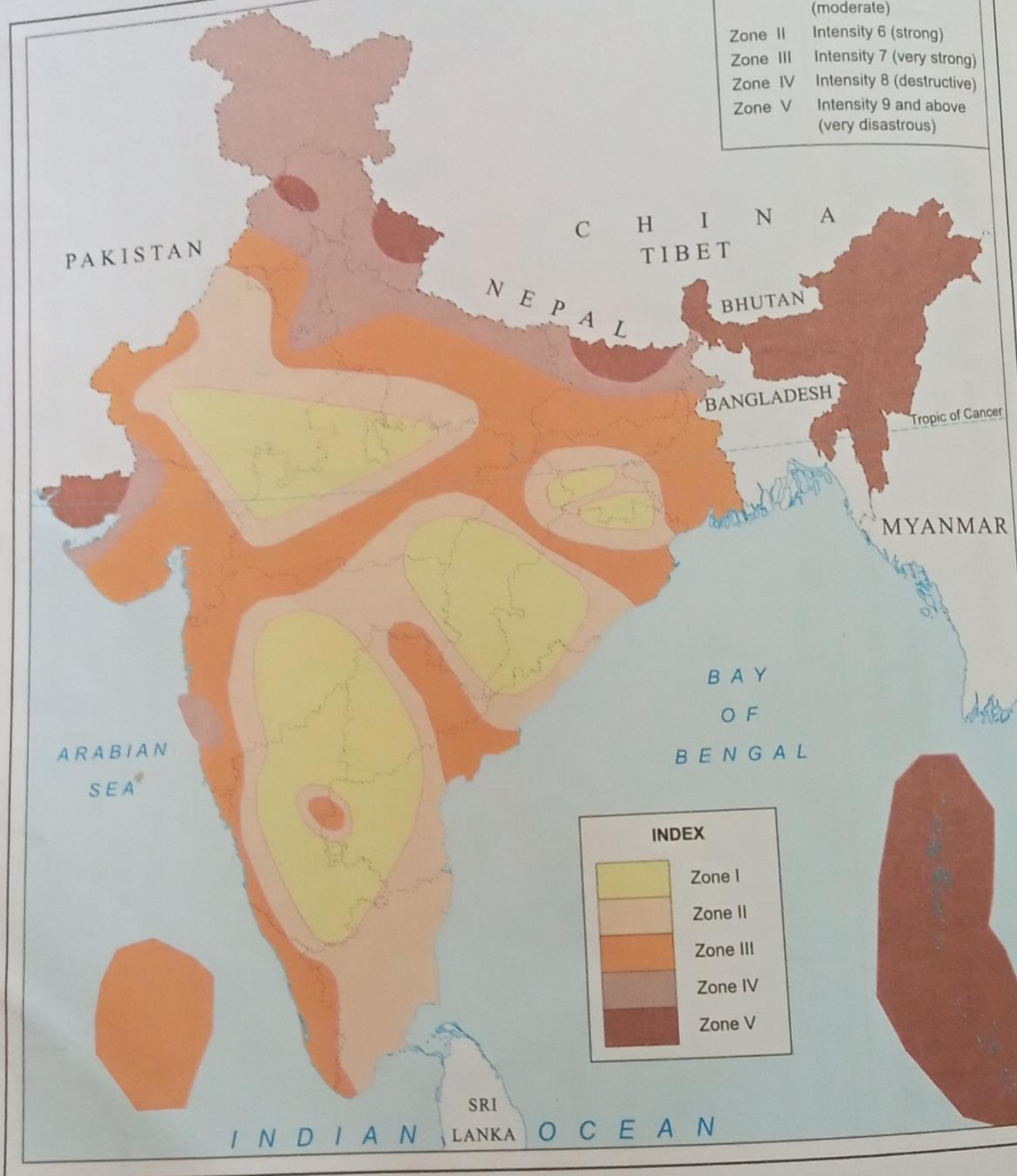


## INDIA Earthquake Zones

The earthquake belt in India is mainly confined to the Himalayan region and the Ganga-Brahmaputra valley. However, in the last 50 years, earthquake tremors have been experienced even in the Deccan Plateau which was considered relatively safe and free from earthquakes. The Bureau of Indian Standards has divided India into five earthquake zones on the basis of the intensity of earthquakes.

### REFERENCES

Zone I	Intensity 5 or below (moderate)
Zone II	Intensity 6 (strong)
Zone III	Intensity 7 (very strong)
Zone IV	Intensity 8 (destructive)
Zone V	Intensity 9 and above (very disastrous)
