Simple Past Tense:(Contd.)

In simple past tense, we use second form of the verb with all person.

I/we/they/you/he/she/it +V2 + object

For example. You ate ice cream.

They ate ice cream.

With all person we use second form of the verb.

Here, (ate is the second form of verb eat).

In negative and interrogative sentence,we use helping verb did .

For eg:

I ate ice cream

I did not eat ice cream.(negative sentence)

Did I eat ice cream? (interrogative sentence)

In interrogative and negative sentence

we use V1 .with helping verb did.

One more example:

My mother bought a new dress for me

Did my mother buy a new dress for me?

My mother did not buy a new dress for me.
