Summary

Tribe:-Forest people who led their life in a primitive style.

Shifting cultivation:- the practice of cultivating a plot of land & then shifting to some other piece of land.

Pastoralists:- an animal rearing nomadic group of people who move with their animal wealth in search of pastures.

Reserved forest:- the forests from where nothing could be taken away by the public.

Criminal tribes:- the British branded the nomadic tribes as criminal tribes.

The British interference & laws posed restrictions on their movement in their in their own natural surroundings & took away the long standing freedom of the tribal people.

So, in many parts of India, the tribal communities rose in revolt.
