#### **L-6 PRESENT TENSE**

I have discussed earlier about the Structure of a sentence in present perfect tense:

**Subject + has/have + v3 + object**

For ex. She has distributed toffee

In the above sentence :

She -----subject

(In has and have we write has with she)

distributed -----third form of verb distribute.

toffee ----- object

When we change it into negative and interrogative sentence, then structure will be:

**In negative sentence:**

**S+ has/have + not +v3 + object**

**She has not distributed toffee.**

**In interrogative sentence:**

**has/ have +subject +v3 +object+?**

**Has she distributed toffee?**

One more example:

I have completed my homework.

I have not completed my homework.

Have I completed my homework?
