DIALOGUE WRITING

Dialogue is an important form of communication. In order to write an effective dialogue, one needs to be quite imaginative and dramatic.

Important Points to consider.

1. Pay full attention to the subject of the dialogue.
 2. Try to imagine how each character would speak.
 3. Use simple, colloquial language.
 4. Be brief and to the point in your answers.
 5. In asking questions, you should be particular about the type of information you wish to seek.
 6. Use the same tense in the answer as is used in the question, and vice-versa.

SOLVED EXAMPLE
