## Flash fiction or micro-fiction

Flash fiction, also known as micro-fiction, is a story form as short as just six words to a few hundred words. For example:

Started writing a story. Got writer's block.  
Gave up.

Ernest Hemingway wrote this six-word story:

Baby shoes. For sale. Never worn.

Keep these points in mind while writing flash fiction.

Start abruptly- you don't have the time to set scenes and build character.

Don't use too many characters you won't have the time to describe your characters. Even a name may not be useful in a micro-fiction unless it conveys a lot of additional information.

Make your last line very effective.

A bridge after writing, as much as you can.

Write flash fiction story on a topic of your choice.
