ANSWER: 1. Temperate grasslands have hot summers and cold winters. Rainfall is moderate. The amount of annual rainfall influences the height of grassland vegetation, with taller grasses in wetter region.

- Ans 2. The animal species such as prairie wolves, bison, prairie dogs, antelopes, rabbits, coyotes are found in the prairie grasslands.
- The varieties of birds such as eagles, hawks, and owls are found here.

- The cattle such as goats and sheeps are reared due to availability of grass.
- Ans: 3. The soil and climate of Prairies are the most suitable for the cultivation of wheat and maize. So the production of wheat is so large that USA exports surplus wheat to other countries. Therefore, the Prairies of North America are called 'Wheat basket of the world'.
