Observe the following examples:

Example:- Multiply 13by2.

Solution:- First method using Repeated

Addition $13 \times 2 = 13 + 13 = 26$

Therefore, $13 \times 2 = 26$

Second method:-Write the numbers
according to place Value shown below

T O

1 3

× 2

2 6

STEPS:1.Multiplying the ones:

$$3\text{ones} \times 2 = 6\text{ones}$$

Write 6 under ones column.

2.Multiply the tens:

$$1\text{ten} \times 2 = 2\text{tens}$$

Write 2 under tens column

Thus,the product of 13and2 is 26.
