Phrases and Idioms

As we have already discussed that, a phrase is a group of two or more words functioning as a meaningful unit within a sentence. We were discussing about types of phrase. Today, we will discuss about verb phrase.

Verb Phrase-In a sentence, when verb comes with more than one word and functioning as a meaningful unit, it is called verb phrase.

For example-He is playing cricket.

She has to go Delhi today.

In the above sentences, is playing and has to go are verb phrase.
