It is very easy to make V4 and V5 by adding ing and so or es but for V2 and V3 you have to remember and work hard so today I am giving you strong verb forms:-

Present	past	past participle
V1	V2	V3
Eat	ate	eaten
Arise	arose	arisen
Buy	bought	bought
Catch	caught	caught
Cast	cast	cast
Dig	dug	dug
Bear	bore	borne
Beat	beat	beaten

So above all verbs form are changing some letters to become v2 and V3.

Every main verb has two kinds.

Transitive verb

Intransitive verb

Need object

doesn't need object

For understanding object in the sentence you have to see verb and ask question and if the question answers what or whom that verbs are transitive verb and when the answer of the verbs don't what or whom that is not object. Just look examples

I eat an apple.

We played football.

She swims in the river.

Tiger caught a deer.

The birds sit on the tree.

We see verb eat, played, swim, caught, and sit.

What eat :- apple

What played :- football

Where swims :- in the river

Whom caught :- deer

Where sits:- on the tree

So eat, played, catch are transitive verb because they answer what or whom and swim, and sit are Intransitive verb because they answer where.
